

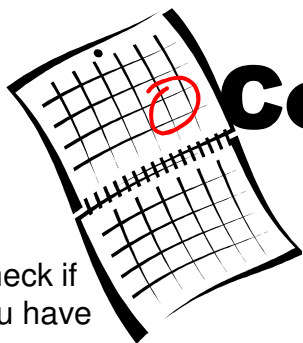

Special Routing for Kiwanis Document Shredding & Recycling Event Sep 30, 2023



- Event entry will NOT use the normal Recycle Park entrance off Rt 306 as that will continue to be used for normal Recycle Park drop off
- Vehicle queuing will follow the path shown above through Herrick-Hovey-Seminary and then Parkview Dr. Entry into Recycle Park will be based on your time in line as best as possible.
- When you get to the Park Gate, show your flyer that indicates what items you have to recycle
- Based upon what you have, you will be routed to the fastest lane to minimize your wait time
- There will not be any power equipment to unload large metal items. If you cannot unload your own vehicle, please bring help..
- Historically there are long lines at 9am but a lull in traffic around 10am
